#### **Call to Order, Welcome Remarks**

- 1. Chairman Guy Simpson called the meeting to order, offered a welcome/thank you for attending the meeting. We had pushed out the original meeting date of 3/10 to 3/17 due to Spring Break. Went over the agenda of the meeting/shared on the screen/Zoom. Guy then opened the meeting in prayer. The Deacon body then broke into individual rooms to pray for each of the pastors on campus. Deacons attending the meeting via Zoom prayed for pastors not in attendance on campus. Upon returning from praying for staff, Buddy Linder prayed for the recent Choir/Mission Trips.
- 2. <u>New Deacon Ordination Process</u>: (Guy Simpson comments) Next New Deacon Training is scheduled for March 24<sup>th</sup>, note the time of 3:30pm. April training is TBD and Matt Porter is setting this up.

## Ministry Teams – Dan Trantham:

- 1. Lord's Supper Ordinance Administration Team Jim Roberts: Next Lord's Supper is Good Friday, March 29<sup>th</sup>, pretty much full roster, always need alternates. Prep on March 28<sup>th</sup> at 1pm.
- 2. Hospital Visitation Team Ron Shields: Nothing new to report, staffed and operation. Fortunately, we have not had too many members in the hospital. New reporting system we will hear about later in the meeting.
- 3. Widows Team Don Johnston: Since last meeting, assigned 4 more ladies. There is one more lady, waiting on response from one of the Deacon's. Thank you to all the men taking on a widow recently.
- 4. Baptism Ordinance Team Kreg Bryant: Pastor Keith will be baptizing his niece, Ruby Hoyer, Sunday after Easter. Kreg also gave an update that for the next 5 months he and Tami will live in Colorado. Joining their son/wife in Boulder. Will be participating on the mission trip later this summer in Colorado. beginning of March. Exciting to see so many volunteers rotating in this Team.
- 5. New Member Candidate Visitation Team Dan Trantham for Paul Chastain: Paul didn't have anything but praise the Lord for several new member candidates joining of late. ## <u>Updates from Pastors/Staff in attendance</u>

## **Senior Pastor Keith Sanders:**

- Vision Team to be pulled back together again to focus on the pillars (who we are as a
  congregation and what's important to us) that was come about from the last Vision Team when
  the church was nearing debt free a few years back. The last Vision Team is where we came up
  with the pillars such as Soli Deo Gloria, Stewardship, Outreach to the Community, etc. Also, we
  came up with the financial principals we have today.
  - 40 to 50 people and an extension of the Long-Range Planning committee
  - Keith will present some ideas to the staff at the annual staff retreat later in March
  - Been several years since the last Vision Team and we need to look at the next ~10 years
- Church wide picnic on Father's Day in June. Lord willing, we will have the certificate of occupancy for the north lot. Dedication ceremony as well. Lawrence leading this effort.
- New Vision Team planned to be announced at the Father's Day church service. Jim Flick to be the Chairman & Kreg Bryan the Vice Chair of the Vision Team.
  - o 5 Meetings over the next 10 months starting in September.
    - At the end of these 10 months, the goal is to bring a proposal first to the Deacon's and then the Church body.
- Deacon Candidate Counsel been conducting interviews the last 3 weeks and finishing up over the next week. The Vietnamese church has 12 men to license in the ministry.

  - 5/26 the Ordination Service
- Dr. Bart Barber to give an address at the 5/26 Ordination Service. Pastor Keith will also give a charge to the congregation. Dr. Dan Dang will have a part for their congregation. Service will be followed by fellowship and a celebration.

## <u>Associate Pastor – Administration Scott Knox:</u>

- Things continue to go well on the North lot. West lot, still working on all sorts of things. Irrigation, landscaping, etc. Lot will be open for Easter Sunday service.
- Budget & Giving updates ~\$6.1m is the budget for the current fiscal year and if current trends continue, we should end up around \$5.6m or \$5.7m giving for the fiscal year. Finance committee aware and we do have a very aggressive budget.
- Ministry Plan staff working incredibly hard, have put their plan together and provided that to the Ministry Plan committee who are working on the overall plan.

## <u>Associate Pastor – Missions & Evangelism Lawrence Duhon:</u>

- Next Saturday, 9am, going out to invite people to attend our events for Holy Week.
- We have an opening at the Carlisle nursing home where Kreg Bryant has been preaching for many years each Sunday at 10am
- Another opening at Whitley Place nursing home as well on Saturday mornings
- International Friends ministry adding people nearly every week to our English and second language program. This ministry meets on Thursday mornings.
- Over 50 people gathering from our community learning American Sign Language on Thursday evenings.
- 5 mission trips went out last month. 133 people were out on mission last month. Every team back except for the Vigoren's who are coming back soon
- Great to see some new people that have never been on a mission trip signing up

## Minister – Senior Adults Mike Gonzales:

- GAP ministry doing well. Currently having sessions on Alzheimer's/Dementia. Last Thursday
  the scheduled speaker (Michelle Kimzey, professor at TCU that specializes in Dementia) never
  made it due to traffic/accident but has been rescheduled. Group that was there was great and
  able to talk about some other topics.
- GAP game day this Thursday (March 21<sup>st</sup>)
- Lunch & Learn's starting up with the first one to discuss how to proof safe your home for kids/grandkids
- GAP breakfast on the 4<sup>th</sup> of April. Guest speaker, Stephen Collins from Cross City Church Euless giving a talk about leaving a legacy.
- Fellowship in the park on April 19<sup>th</sup> 5 7pm at Bear Creek Park.
- Day trip on Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup> to the ICR Discovery Center in Dallas. Cost is \$35 which includes the bus transport & lunch.
