Deacon Widows Ministry Training Why do we have a Deacon Widows Ministry?

James 1:27 (NASB)

Deacon Widows Ministry Training Why do we have a Deacon Widows Ministry?

<u>From the Deacon Handbook – Service of Deacons</u>

As the original deacons were called to minister to the widows within their church body, we believe ministering to our widows to be a primary responsibility of our deacons. The FBCK Widows ministry is a vital ministry to widows within our church body. It is expected that each of our serving deacons will actively minister to at least one widow.



Deacon Widows Ministry Training Who are the Widows we serve?

- Church members
- ♦ Widows 60 years of age or older (1 Timothy 5:9)
- ♦ There are currently 133 widows who meet this criteria



Deacon Widows Ministry Training Who are the Widows we serve?

Widows who need assignment —	>	6
Widows who are assigned ————————————————————————————————————	→	117
Widows who have moved	>	16
Widows who are deceased —	>	22
Widows who are not yet eligible for assignment ———	>	3
Widows who do not want a deacon assignment ———	>	10
Widows who married again —	→	4



Deacon Widows Ministry Training There are different types of Widows

- Widows living with their families
- Widows living in their own homes with family close by
- Widows living in their own homes with no family close by
- Widows living in nursing homes and/or extended-care facilities



Deacon Widows Ministry Training

What are the expectations of the Deacon?

- Show interest The widow wants to know that her deacon cares about her
- ♦ Stay in touch phone, in person visits (Deacon and his wife)
- Build a relationship with your widow(s)
- ♦ How often should I contact my Widow? it depends on her circumstances



Deacon Widows Ministry Training

How do I minister to my widow?

- The most important thing for the Deacon to do is to stay in touch with your widow
- Keep your eyes and ears open to any issues or problems your widow may have
- Assist her when necessary to solve whatever problem she has
- We have a Deacon Widows Benevolence fund to cover any realistic expenses
